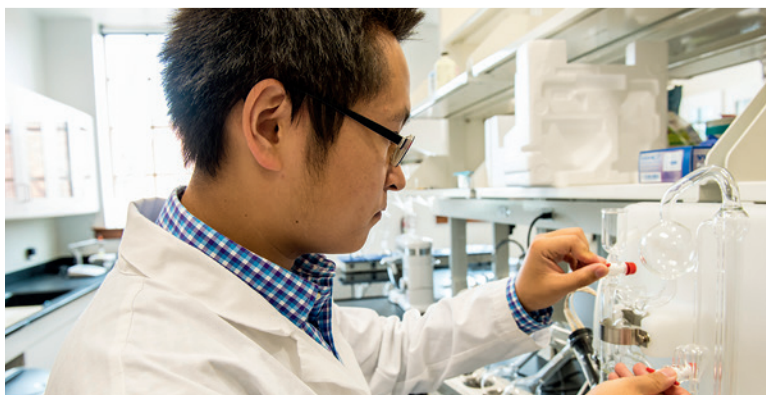
A degree within
